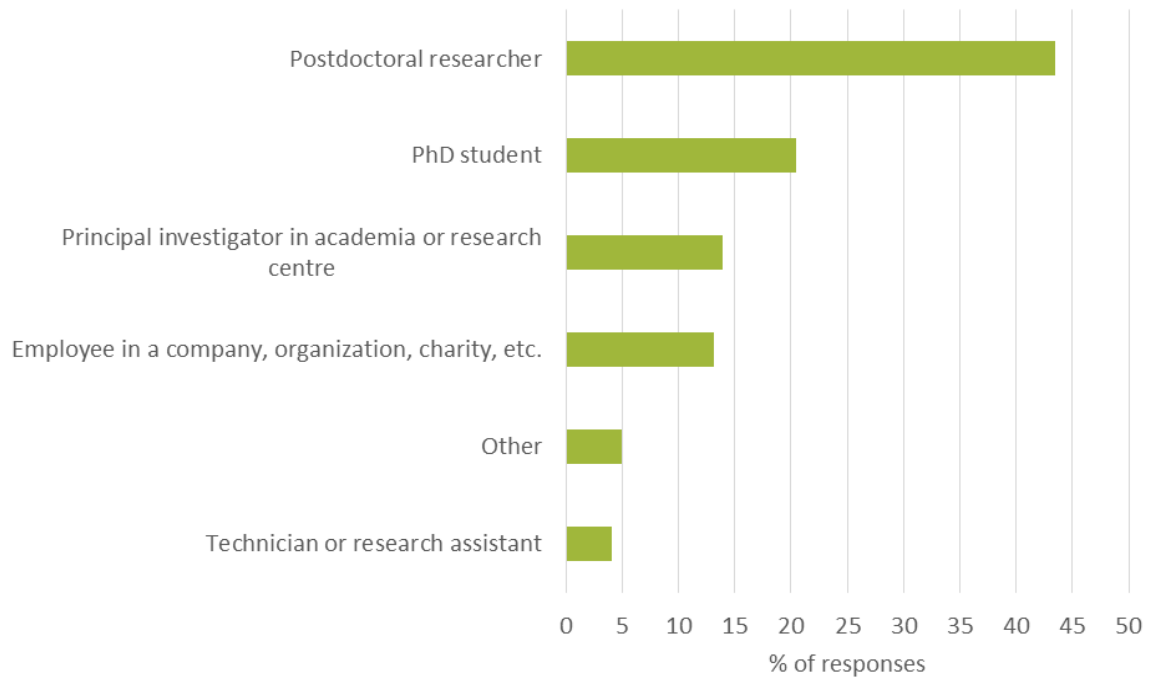

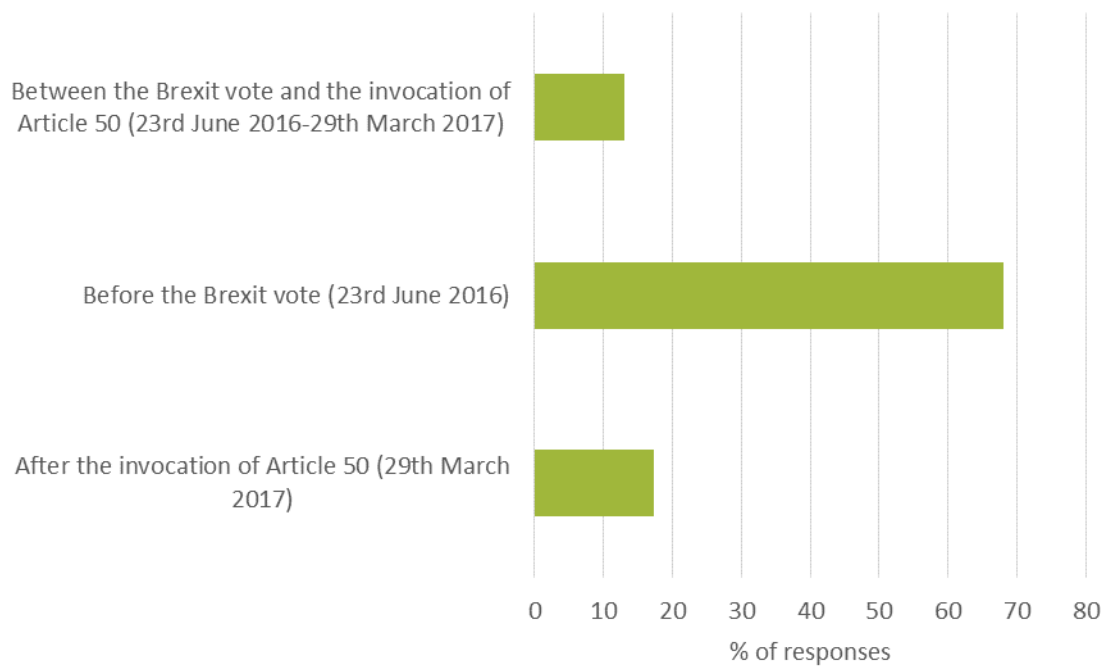

1) What is your current position in the UK?



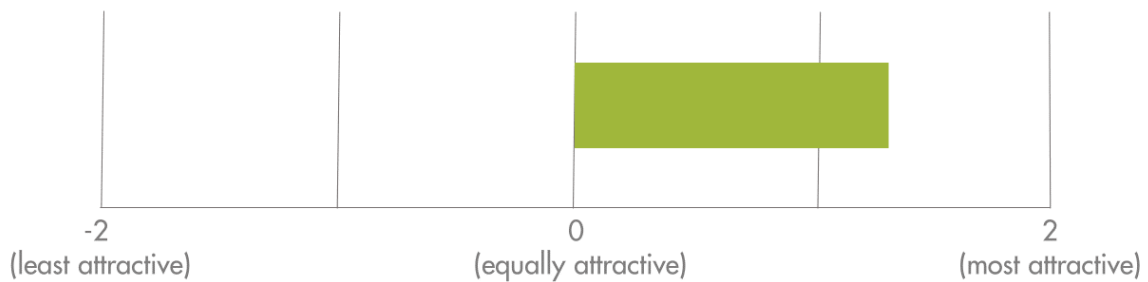
2) When did you (last) move to the UK?

Average score: 1.30

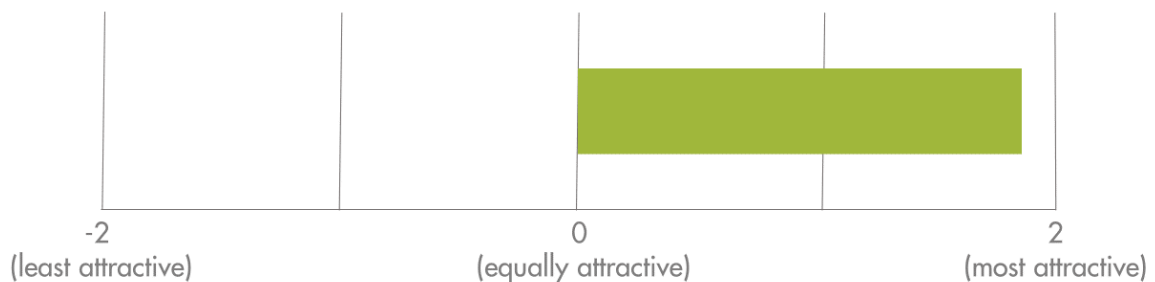
Marks between -2 (least attractive) to 2 (most attractive)

Average score: 1.84

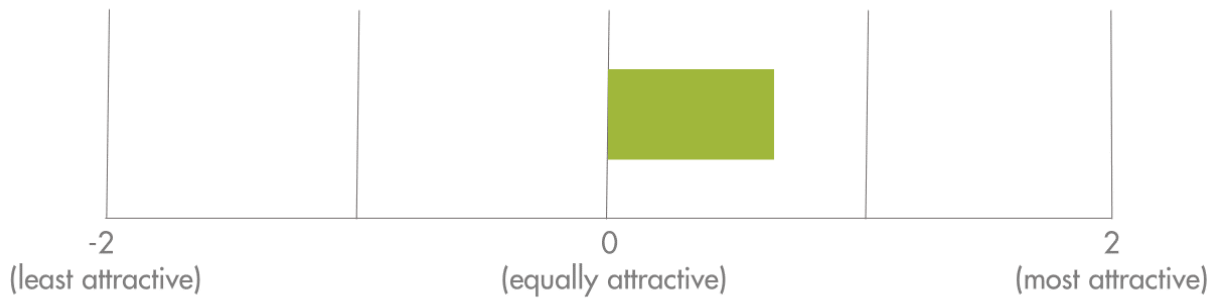
Marks between -2 (least attractive) to 2 (most attractive)

Average score: 0.66

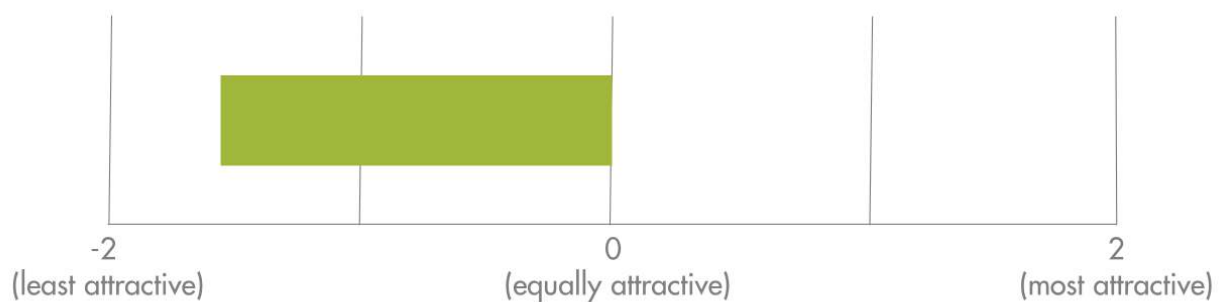
Marks between -2 (least attractive) to 2 (most attractive)



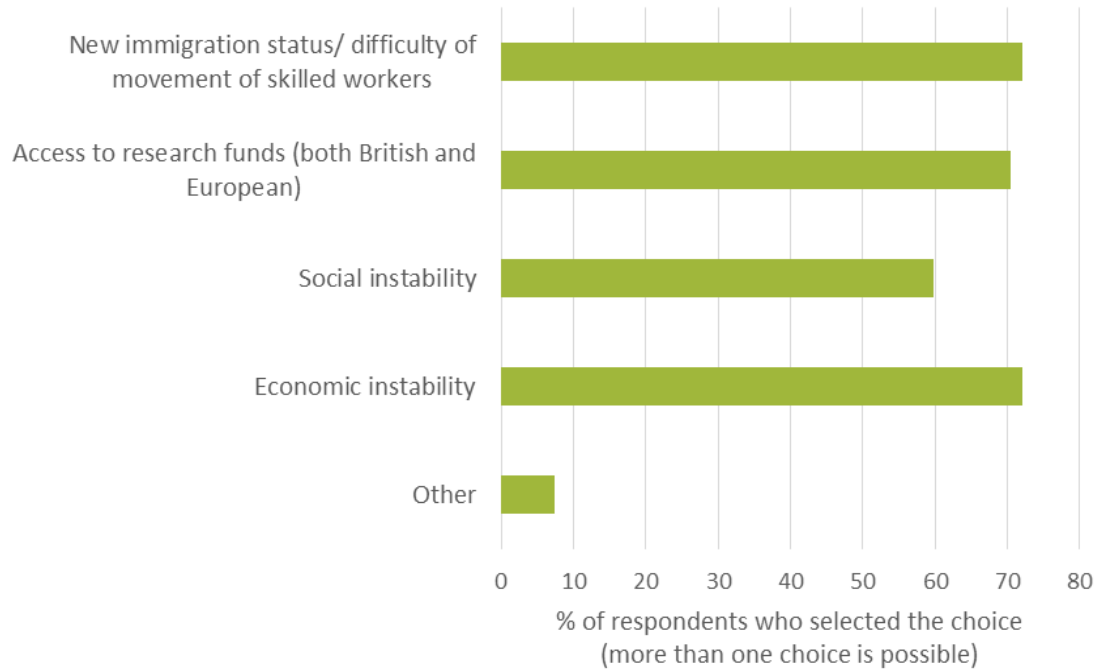

Marks between -2 (least attractive) to 2 (most attractive)



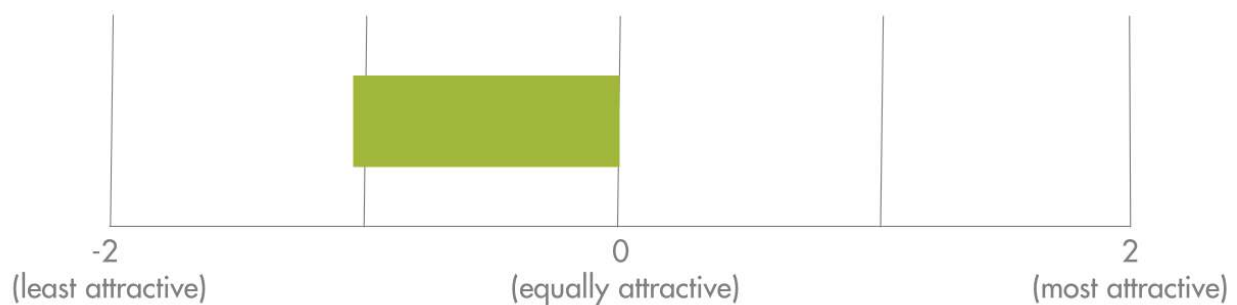
7) What would be the main reasons for the above answer?



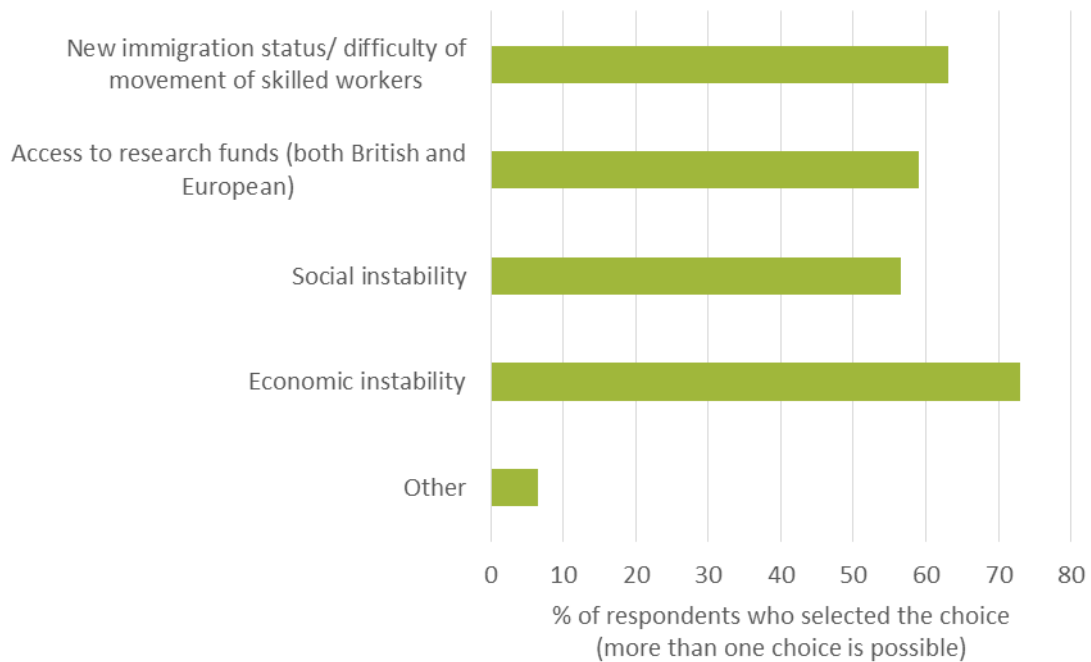
